DIRECTIONS: 1lb. = 3 cups
We recommend wearing gardening gloves
when using this product.

Composting Directions:

Select a partially shaded site that is on level ground and at least 4 feet by 4 feet.

Add the initial layer of waste including twigs and branches for air circulation. Layers should be 6 to 12 inches deep.

Add **Compost Starter** – 1 cup for 16 sq ft. of layer area.

Evenly moisten the layer but do not soak.

Repeat with additional layers of waste adding Compost Starter and moisture with each new layer.

Turn the pile often, i.e. once a week, to allow air to penetrate to the center.

Tips & Suggestions:

- Reducing the size of waste by shredding will speed the composting process.
- Any organic waste can be composted including kitchen scraps, leaves, grass clippings, etc.
- Composting meat scraps may attract animal pests.
- If you experience problems these can often be addressed by adding Compost Starter and turning the pile.
- If you notice a foul odor the process has turned anaerobic (not enough air). Turn the pile more often to allow air to penetrate to the center.

Instrucciones de abono:

Elija un lugar con sombra parcial que esté en suelo nivelado y tenga por lo menos 4 pies x 4 pies (1,2 m x 1,2 m).

Agregue la capa inicial de desechos incluyendo ramas pequeñas y grandes para la circulación del aire. Las capas deben tener entre 6 pulgadas (15,2 cm) y 12 pulgadas (30,5 cm) de profundidad.

Agregue **Compost Starter** – una taza por cada 16 pies cuadrados (1,5 m²) de superficie de capa.

Humedezca uniformemente la capa pero no la empape.

Repita con capas adicionales de desecho agregando Compost Starter y humedezca con cada nueva capa.

Mueva el montón con frecuencia, por ejemplo una vez a la semana, para dejar que el aire penetre hasta el centro.

Consejos y sugerencias:

- Reducir el tamaño de los desechos desmenuzándolos acelerará el proceso de abono.
- Cualquier desecho orgánico se puede convertir en abono incluyendo sobras de cocina, hojas, recortes de papel, etc.
- Usar restos de carne como abono puede atraer a las alimañas.
- Si usted tiene problemas, a menudo se pueden solucionar agregando Compost Starter y moviendo el montón.
- Si usted nota mal olor el proceso se ha vuelto anaeróbico (no hay suficiente aire). Mueva el montón con mayor frecuencia para dejar que el aire penetre hasta el centro.

Almacene en un lugar fresco y seco, fuera del alcance de niños y mascotas.
