DIRECTIONS FOR USE:

Soil: Use one pint (16 oz.) per acre.

Problem Soil: For saline, alkali, and water penetration problems, use 1 quart (32 oz.) per acre, first application.

Row Crops: Mix with starter or side dress fertilizer. Can also be metered into first irrigation water.

Trees and Vines: Dilute in sufficient water for coverage and spray soil surface to be irrigated or meter into first irrigation water.

Transplants: Mix with transplant water to apply one pint (16 oz.) per acre.

Plants: Use four fluid ounces per 100 gallons of water to reduce surface tension and improve wetting in agricultural sprays.

If foaming is a problem, use an anti-foaming agent in the spray formulation or fertilizer solution.
